WELCOME BACK! A warm welcome to all those children who have joined us in reception or in other year groups.

Primary Academy as you are aware we have returned to the new academic year as an Academy. There are a few changes, one of which is we now operate a cashless system. Everything has to be paid either by Credit/Debit card via the school office or via online banking. Please see the bank details below:

The Reference Number should be your Child's Initial and Surname and the Activity.

Childcare vouchers are still an accepted payment for Breakfast and the after school club. Ideally, we need you to pay for both of the clubs on a daily or weekly basis. This will reduce the number of invoices that have to be raised at the end of each month. Eventually we hope to have an online booking system for both of the clubs, you will have to book your child's place and pay at the same time. (Similar to the way you order the hot meals).

School Photos Wednesday, 18th September. The photographer will be here at 8:30am. **If you would like to have a family photo you will need to bring your children along to the KS2 hall for 8:30am. All individual photos will be taken during the school day.**

Please make sure that all girls with hair longer than shoulder length, have it tied back for the school day. This is to ensure it does not get in the way during lesson time and in particular during PE. If hair is not tied back, staff will give your child a hair tie, particularly for PE.

Stud earrings will be covered for PE too. All children will be given assistance for the first few weeks. Medical tape will be used (recommended by County).

Nail varnish—we will ask children to remove it for the next school day. After that it will be removed by school staff.

All KS2 children need an outdoor PE kit (any colour sports trousers, a hoodless top and trainers. The weather is getting colder they will need to be wrapped up warmly. PE outside continues through the winter in KS2.

Please make sure ALL children in both KS1 & 2 bring their kit on a Monday and take it home on a Friday.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB Please remember to let us know if you do not need a place for your child, otherwise it blocks a place another parent may need. The terms and conditions state that if the place is not cancelled you will still be charged.
